

# MAX GNANT

Born in Männedorf - Switzerland in 1990, Max completed elementary school in Feldbach before graduating from the Küssnacht cantonal school, a year as an intern at the Junges Schauspielhaus Zurich and then a Bachelor of Arts in theater at the Accademia Teatro Dimitri (italian speaking part of Switzerland).

This was followed by two in-depth years of study in classical spoken theater at the Theaterakademie Vorpommern - Germany, with a final ZAV audition in Berlin and a permanent engagement in Bavaria immediately afterwards.

Since 2015, Max Gnant has been working mainly in the theater, mostly as an actor and sometimes as an initiator/producer of plays and concepts. In addition to the theater, Max Gnant is also repeatedly used as a performer with moving qualities (e.g. in the circus Chnopf).

In addition to his artistic activities, Max Gnant is also engaged to convey artistic expression as a personal resource for everyone. Be it in the management of a theater club for non-professionals of different ages (ThiK and Kurtheater Baden, Maximtheater etc.) or as the initiator of a movement exchange in the Federal Asylum Center.
